Each grave site is decorated with the flag of the United States and that of the host country.

The U.S. Ambassador to the country usually attends, and the President's Memorial Proclamation is read. In addition, there are wreath-laying ceremonies with military bands and units in attendance. More than 124,500 soldiers are interred in 14 foreign countries.

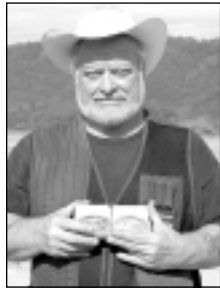

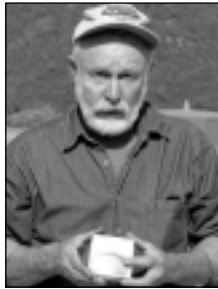
